Brian Albert Bredfeldt, 71, of Port Charlotte, Florida, quietly and peacefully passed away in the arms of his daughter, surrounded by family, and went straight to Heaven on Monday, July 18, 2016.

He was born December 28, 1944, in Merrill, Wisconsin, to John Walter and Adnell (Tatro) Bredfeldt.

Brian grew up in Iowa and Missouri, and graduated with a bachelor's of arts in philosophy and a minor in religion from Iowa Wesleyan College in Mount Pleasant, Iowa. 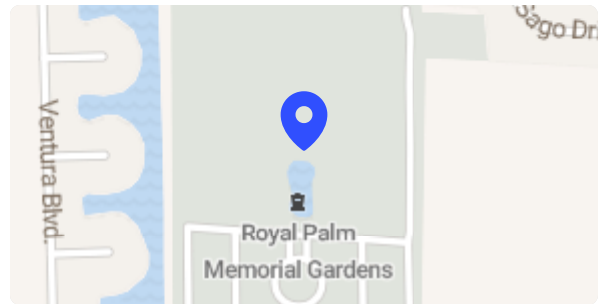

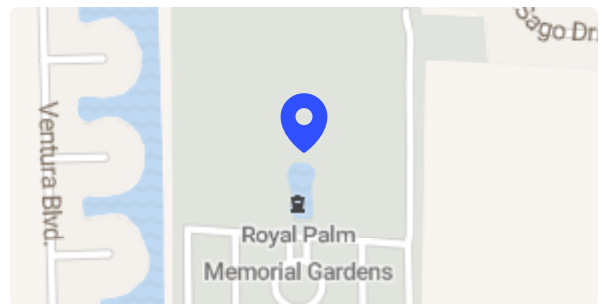
