Sophie was born on February 7, 1932 to Otelia Roc and Jean-Baptiste Asce Denis in Juan Isidoro (Province of Barahona) in the Dominican Republic. She was the 6th child born among 11 siblings. The family later travelled back to Haiti where they settled in Port-au-Prince.

Sophie attended the Madame Boisson grade school. She completed her academic studies under the Brevet d'etudes professionnelles. Her father discovered that she had a passion for sewing and designing clothing. He enrolled her in seamstress classes where she also took up embroidery.

Sophie was a devoted daughter, sister and friend. She loved the Lord and spent most of her time serving the church and her family. She was a gracious hostess. She loved to read and sing.

She was the first person in the family to travel to the United States in August of 1965 where she settled in Boston Massachusetts. She later became the proud mother of John Emanuel Denis, whom she nurtured and reared in the fear and admonition of the Lord. She was wed to Maurice Rozin who was a devoted father and integral presence in John's upbringing.

Sophie led a meaningful life supporting her family while working as a health care provider in Boston. She also was a faithful servant at the Temple Salem Seventh Day Adventist Church in Dorchester, Massachusetts where she worshipped and served for many years as a deaconess.

After her husband's passing she relocated to Florida with her son John and his wife Angela. They later became proud parents to Adam & Naomi, Sophie's beloved grandchildren. 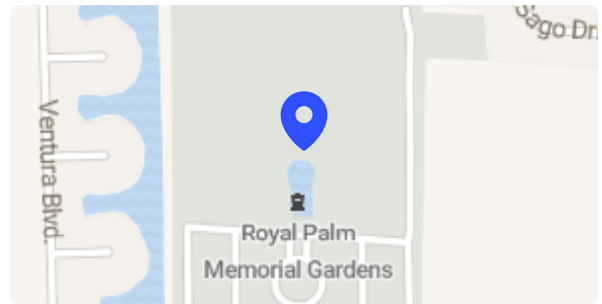

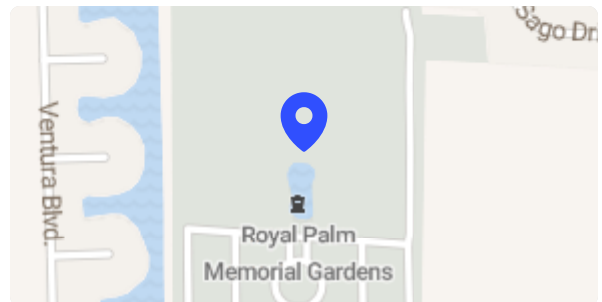
